Old business-

- a. Status of irrigation start-up Stone Cross contacted and will do Friday, May 26,2023 or the week of the 29th.
- b. Status of street light repair bid Waiting on a part, they confirmed that was received on 5/19 and will start building the fixture next week. Also, the street light at 6521 Manton is going on and off, so hopefully it can be repaired while the vendor is here.
- c. Siding bids Omni roofing and siding still working on estimate.

- d. Roof inspection for potential hail damage last summer or fall the Claim for severe granular loss and actual shingle samples from the following 5 of the buildings have been submitted to CertainTeed:
 - 8832-8848 Oxley, 8824–8836 Denton, 8825-8837 Denton, 8721-8733 Hanworth, and 8604-8624 Bromley.
- e. Our garbage collection contract is up for renewal this fall. Discussion on pros and cons of switching to Johnston City Garbage collection was made. The Board asked Lisa to negotiate a bid with our current vendor, Waste Connections, before we decide which way to go on garbage collection.

New business- walk through findings discussed and will be referred to appropriate vendors . Will get bids for mud jacking and concrete projects.
